Teacher of the Year Nominations Criteria

- Short Resume. List teaching experience, continuing education, professional honors/awards, civic and community service honors/awards.
- Description of the school where you teach (public, private, charter), grades served, student population.
- Description subjects taught and how you have included aerospace education into the teaching curriculum. This should be double-spaced and not exceed three pages. Include examples of how topics on flight and aerospace education have enhanced the student learning environment. (Examples of activities, research by students, student projects would be helpful to the evaluation team). If Air Force Association funding (such as an Educator Grant or other chapter funding) was provided describe how these funds were used to benefit the students.
- Include examples/samples that might help in the evaluation. This may include a curriculum outline, sample lesson plan, selected photos, newspaper articles, student product, etc.

Military Families Eligible for Free SAT/ACT Test Preparation Software

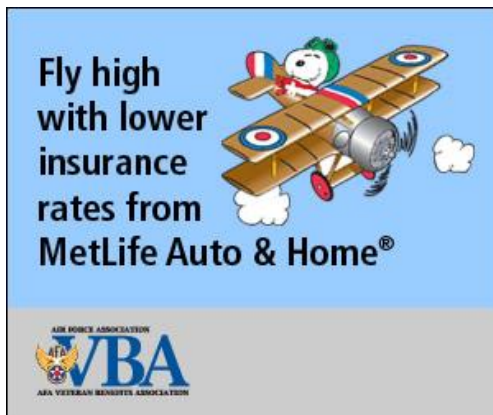

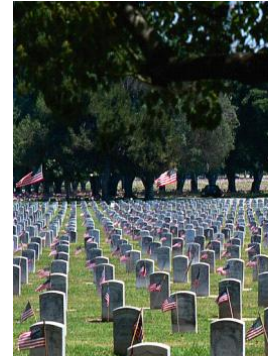
